<p>Pre-Net</p> <p>Optional</p>	<p><i>(Five minutes before the net)</i></p> <p>This is <i>(call sign)</i>. The ARES R1D1 net will begin in approximately five minutes.</p> <p><i>(One minute before the net)</i></p> <p>This is <i>(call sign)</i>. The ARES R1D1 net will begin in approximately one minute.</p>
<p>Preamble</p>	<p>This is <i>(call sign)</i>, Net Control Operator for the Amateur Radio Emergency Service Region 1 District 1 net. The mission of the Amateur Radio Emergency Service is to provide reliable and alternate communications to our served agencies in times of emergency, disaster, or national crisis.</p> <p>Our district serves agencies in Larimer and Weld counties. My name is <i>(name)</i>, and I am located in <i>(city)</i>, Colorado. This net meets every Thursday evening at 7:00 pm local time for the purpose of planning, practicing, and discussing the activities of the ARES Region 1 District 1 group. This is a directed net, and all traffic will go through Net Control.</p>

<p>Net Practices</p>	<p>This net is open to anyone licensed to operate on this repeater and interested in amateur radio public service communications. This net is affiliated with the Amateur Radio Emergency Service of the American Radio Relay League, however, ARES or ARRL membership is not required to check.</p> <p>This is <i>(call sign)</i>, Net Control for the ARES R1D1 net.</p>
<p>Check-ins</p>	<p>This net will accept check-ins in order of ARES affiliation. All stations will have an opportunity to check in; however, please wait for your appropriate check-in group</p> <p>When checking in please give the following:</p>

<p>ARES Training</p>	<p>We will now go on to our weekly ARES R1D1 training from <i>(callsign)</i>.</p> <p><i>(after the trainer finishes, thank them)</i></p>
<p>Final check-ins</p>	<p>Before closing, are there any additional stations who would like to check in to the ARES R1D1 net? If so, please call now.</p> <p><i>(Log and recognize any late check-ins)</i></p>

<p>Close</p>	<p>I would like to thank each station for checking in and the NCARC for the use of their repeater this evening. All stations with appropriate privileges are invited to check into the statewide ARES HF net on Sunday mornings at 8 AM on a frequency of 3.810 MHz and the statewide Ares VHF net on Sunday evenings at 8 PM on the Colorado Connection linked repeater system.
